- One in four women are victims of domestic violence in their lifetimes.
- On average victims experience 35 incidents before calling the police.
- Research shows that victims disclose to a range of frontline workers and that the police are often the last resort.

Frontline workers need to understand the impact of, and how to identify, domestic violence. They should also know how to deal with a disclosure and where to refer victims. A DVIRP domestic violence awareness training course will provide all this.
